Visitors to the Earth Pavilion get the chance to move rocks with a real digging machine and even to explode a rock area.

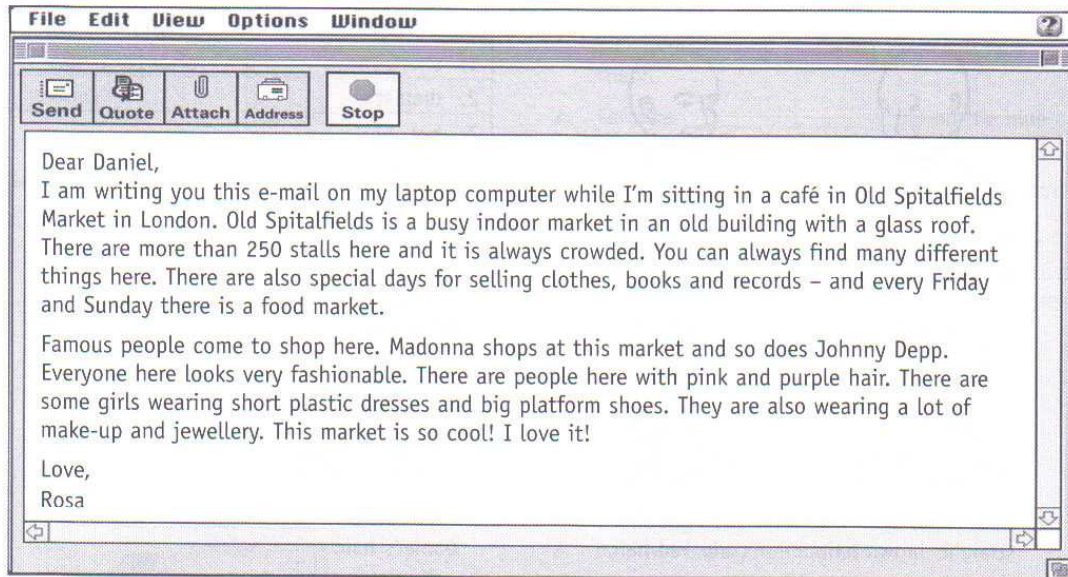
The Fire Pavilion
